BEGINNERS FACE PAINTING TECHNIQUES WORKSHOP

THINGS TO BRING:

- A pack of baby wipes. You will be doing LOTS of painting, wiping off and painting again. A flannel or face-washer can be used instead, but will need to be washed out often.
- A container for brush water. An ice cream container, takeaway container or plastic bowl is fine. Otherwise, professional "brush baths" are available from Fancy That for \$22. Ring to check availability as these are often a pre-order item.
- A small clean tea towel, face washer or similar. It will get stained so nothing fancy please. Alternatively, paper towel is fine.
- Your camera or phone, to take photos of your masterpieces!
- A pen or pencil for note taking. A workbook will be provided.
- Drinks and your lunch as we will have a short lunch break. We have a kettle and microwave if needed.
- Old clothing that doesn't matter if paint gets on it! We recommend wearing short sleeves as your arm will be your canvas. Shorts or skirts can work well too if you want to practice on your thighs.
- You will need some appropriate face paints. See Page Two for information.

THINGS TO KNOW:

Due to the venue size and so you can get the most out of the workshop, we can only accommodate participants, so children or friends are unable to attend with you. We will begin promptly at 11am and endeavour to finish on time at 4pm, but please make allowances for extra time as workshops occasionally run over time.

During the workshop, feel free to ask questions! No question is too silly and someone else may be thinking it as well. Please move around for a better look if you can't see something, and don't hesitate to ask for something to be repeated. Take notes, take photos, TRY TRY TRY every technique and by the end of the workshop you'll be laughing, having a great time and amazed at the creations you have made.

- 1x ea TAG brand 32g
 - o White
 - o Black
 - o Red
 - o Pink
 - o Yellow
- 1x Three or four colour 30g "one stroke" face paint cake of your choice
- 1x Four, five or six colour 50g "split cake" face paint cake of your choice
- 6x Half-round face painting sponges
- 1x Puffer bottle white holographic glitter
- 1x Atomiser bottle
- Brushes:
 - o 3x Round (#0, #2 & #6)
 - o 1x Filbert #4 or 6
 - o 1x Angle # 6
 - o 1 x Flat #12 (3/4 inch)
 - o Special petal brush

IMPORTANT NOTES:

Our workshop is based around the items listed in the Intro Kit so it is advisable to purchase this set to get the most out of your workshop. However, if you are planning to face paint often, or as a business, it is better value to invest in a full Professional Kit.

You are welcome to bring your own supplies, however you will need PROFESSIONAL quality face paints. You will be unable to complete the workshop with liquid paints or "cheap shop" / craft store supplies. Please check with us if you are not sure.

Face paint supplies will be available for purchase on the day. Alternatively, you can pop into Fancy That any time prior to the workshop to purchase them, or phone/message ahead of time to have your supplies put aside for you. Each kit can easily be tailored to suit your individual needs & budget.
